YWAM Strategic Frontiers is partnered with a sister NGO (Nongovernmental Organization) called ECI (Educational Concepts International) in Afghanistan. As in many restricted access countries, the proverbial tent making skill is required to establish a presence in country. ECI is the NGO we will be operating under. They are based in Kabul, the capital city of Afghanistan but have projects all over the country.

ECI statement of Purpose: *As a Non-profit, charitable organization, is committed to provide sustainable, values based education within developing nations around the globe.*
