Obedience / Sacrifice

1 Samuel 15:22 says: "Obedience is better than sacrifice".

This is a passage that I have been mulling over for quite some time now and it has been quite challenging.

I may sacrifice out of obedience but it is not the sacrifice that is the act of righteousness but the obedience.

Obedience becomes an act of sacrifice when we die to our own way and make a conscience choice to obey. Obedience leads to an acceptable sacrifice.

Sacrifice may be easily understood and even be commended and applauded but obedience is not always understood and many times goes against the "norms" of protocol or society or even our own hearts.

To be in the place of obedience to God is the safest place to be. It is better to be in the heart of Afghanistan with my family in obedience than to be sitting in suburbia Colorado Springs in disobedience. That is why hearing the clear voice of God is so critical to our lives and that as the NLV version of Mat 4:4 says "People need more than the bread for their life; they must feed on every word of God".

When I say the safest place is obedience to God I do not mean safety from trial, physical harm or suffering but rather safety from the enemy who would seek to derail us from our hope and future; from our destiny and our calling. Who would not just destroy our body but our souls. Obedience is better than sacrifice.
