WHAT IS YAFTA?

Youth with a mission aviation training academy (YAFTA) is a new school within YWAM. YAFTA will be a 6 month program training missionary pilots and serving Afghanistan. The first three months will take place here in Colorado Springs. During these first three months the students will receive biblical training as well as flight training, allowing each of the students the opportunity to receive their private pilot's license.

The final three months will be the outreach phase of the school and is planned to be in Afghanistan. The students will have the opportunity to teach in the Aviation Education program serving Afghans as well as have the opportunity to shadow missionary pilots who work in this field. This will give students the opportunity to gain practical field experience and see what being a missionary pilot is all about before the students sink all the time and money into all the training required to be a pilot serving on the mission field.

After the students have completed the course they will have several options to choose from. They could come on staff with the YWAM aviation program, they can remain on the field as an intern or they can continue their flight training and become a missionary pilot. We believe that God will use this program to train up many that will go to the ends of the earth to reach those who have never heard the saving message of Jesus. AFGHAN STUDENTS DEPART

Back in December a small group of Afghan students were given the opportunity to come to America to further their studies in aviation. These students had been a part of the Aviation education program we help to serve in Kabul. The students were funded through the FAA to come to America for 10 weeks to learn about air traffic control. These students have now returned to Afghanistan.

You see, even though these students are far more educated than most Afghans, and will have great jobs working for the airport upon their return, they will be government jobs paying very little, about sixty dollars a month. Kabul is an expensive city. Sixty dollars will not even pay for their housing so, these students will have to get second jobs to cover the additional cost of housing and to buy food. Despite these obstacles they each have high hopes and expectations of a great future and rebuilding their devastated country. It is Afghans like these ones we have served that will make the difference.

There will be another group of Afghan students arriving in America in March. Please pray with us for these students that have returned as well as the new students that will be arriving. The students returning to Kabul are going back not only more educated but, have had a change in their world view and had the gospel lived in front of them and presented to them. They have a real chance of helping to change their country.
