Soon after the opening of the first aviation school this past spring, we were able to help our first student achieve his private pilot's license. This was a very exciting time for us and for YWAM Aviation.

Recently YWAM Aviation received its own 501c3 status, meaning that YWAM Aviation is now considered (by the government), a not for profit organization and able to give tax deductible receipts for charitable contributions. This was a very big milestone that we have now crossed! Praise the Lord!!

We had several students signed up to come take part in the aviation school as well as having many applications for staff to come and serve with the school but, at this point we have put everything on hold.

Ray has taken this time to take care of me and our family. Once my health is taken care of and I am able to care for our family again, we will begin the next YWAM Aviation school. 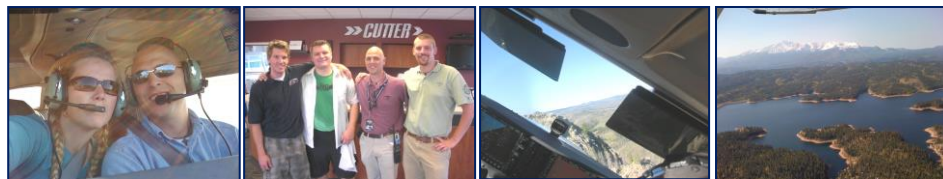
Praise:
